The proposed H-UCLA MC RO WPS Replacement Project will replace the existing reverse osmosis water purification system servicing the dialysis unit in Room 5W-9 at Harbor-UCLA Medical Center. The existing system is approximately 30 years old and has exceeded its expected life cycle. Failure to replace this system will impact the hospital's ability to provide safe dialysis treatment to patients that are admitted to the hospital.

EXEMPT STATUS:

Sections 15301(a), (d), and (f), 15302(c), and 15303 of the State CEQA Guidelines and Classes 1(c), (d), and (i), 2(e), and 3 of the County's Environmental Document Reporting Procedures and Guidelines, Appendix G.

REASONS WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT:

The scope of work consists of the remodeling and replacements made to an existing system. Therefore, the work is within certain classes of projects that have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment because it includes repairs and minor alterations to existing public facilities with negligible or no expansion of use, replacement of features with the same purpose and capacity, placement of small equipment and accessory structures, and installation of equipment at existing facilities.

In addition, based on the record of the proposed Project, it will comply with all applicable regulations, it is not in a sensitive environment and there are no cumulative impacts, unusual circumstances, damage to scenic highways, listing on hazardous waste site lists compiled pursuant to Government Code section 65962.5, or indications that it may cause a substantial adverse change in the significance of a historic resource that would make the exemptions inapplicable.
