DESCRIPTION OR NATURE, PURPOSE, AND BENEFICIARIES OF THE PROJECT:

The proposed Project will remodel the existing X-ray room in order to accommodate an X-ray machine replacement located at the Department of Medical Examiner (DME) headquarters. The existing X-ray equipment has reached its end-of-life and is no longer supported by the original manufacturer. DME has been utilizing a portable X-ray machine as an interim measure, but a permanent replacement is needed in order for DME to continue to provide its services to the County. The proposed project will refurbish and remodel the existing X-ray room due to the existing configuration lacking sufficient cooling, power, and space to accommodate the proposed replacement X-ray equipment.

EXEMPT STATUS:

Categorically Exempt Project in accordance with Sections 15301 (d), 15302, and 15303 of the State CEQA Guidelines and Classes 1(c), 2, and 3 of the County's Environmental Document Reporting Procedures and Guidelines, Appendix G.

REASONS WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT:

The scope of work consists of the remodeling of the interior of an existing X-ray room. Therefore, the work is within certain classes of projects that have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment because it includes repairs and minor alterations to existing public facilities with negligible or no expansion of use, replacement of features with the same purpose and capacity, placement of small equipment and accessory structures, and installation of equipment at existing facilities.

In addition, based on the records of the proposed Project, it will comply with all applicable regulations, it is not in a sensitive environment and there are no cumulative impacts, unusual circumstances, damage to scenic highways, listing on hazardous waste site lists compiled pursuant to Government Code section 65962.5, or indications that it may cause a substantial adverse change in the significance of a historic resource that would make the exemptions inapplicable.
