DESCRIPTION OR NATURE, PURPOSE, AND BENEFICIARIES OF THE PROJECT:

The proposed Project will remodel existing spaces within FDR Park's Senior Center and Gymnasium. To support the Los Angeles County "Delete the Divide" Initiative, stakeholders requested that ISD develop an estimate (with supporting plan) to meet the State grant-funding requirements to construct a technology center within the Firestone-Florence community. As envisioned, the proposed technology center will greatly increase both digital equity and accessibility for the community. This center would be a hub for technology training, educational use, and computer access in an area where many households do not have internet access or a home computer.

REASONS WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT:

The scope of work consists of remodeling the interior of an existing space. Therefore, the work is within certain classes of projects that have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment because the work includes repairs and minor alterations to existing public facilities with negligible or no expansion of use, replacement of features with the same purpose and capacity, and the installation of equipment at existing facilities.

In addition, based on the records of the proposed Project, it will comply with all applicable regulations, it is not in a sensitive environment and there are no cumulative impacts, unusual circumstances, damage to scenic highways, listing on hazardous waste site lists compiled pursuant to Government Code section 65962.5, or indications that it may cause a substantial adverse change in the significance of a historic resource that would make the exemptions inapplicable.
